ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the:

Wayne County Regional Water Storage Project  
Miscellaneous Upgrades 2021

will be received by Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, at the office of the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, 3377 Daansen Road, Walworth, NY 14568, until 9 AM local time on December 10, 2021, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project includes construction of a new chemical feed building at the Brantling Hill Site, and installation of piping, pumps, and ancillary equipment at the Brantling Hill Site, the existing Rt 21 Pump Station Site, and the existing Joy Road Pump Station Site.

Sealed Bids will be received for a General Construction Contract and an Electrical Construction Contract. Each contract includes work at the three different sites. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, as indicated on the Bid Form.

3. For a non-refundable fee, printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Avalon Planroom. If the documents are to be shipped, the Bidder must furnish Avalon with the Bidder’s active UPS or Federal Express account number or pay Avalon for all shipping and handling costs.

The Bidding Documents must be obtained through the Avalon Planroom in order to be considered a Plan Holder of record. Bidding Documents obtained from any other source are for examination only, are not considered complete and are not valid for bidding purposes.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the offices of MRB Group, and the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, 3377 Daansen Road, Walworth, NY 14568, on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:30 PM; or online through internet based construction information subscription services.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, nor Engineer, nor Avalon will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, Wayne County, NY, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities, or to make an award to other than the low bidder. It further reserves the right to limit the amount of the award.

Attention of the bidders is particularly directed to the Bidding Documents which include requirements concerning the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum Wage Rates to be paid under the Contracts. Requirements for MWBE and SDVOB participation in the project are also included in the Bidding Documents.

The Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on November 18, 2021 at 9 AM local time at 3377 Daansen Road, Walworth New York. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Conference is highly encouraged, but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
