

Is My Drinking Water Impacted by the COVID-19 Coronavirus?

It is important for our customers to know that the drinking water supplied by the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority is safe and not impacted by the COVID-19 coronavirus.

The treatment plants of our suppliers utilize a series of treatment processes, including filtration and disinfection, which are effective in removing and/or inactivating pathogens such as bacterium and viruses including the COVID-19 coronavirus.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and World Health Organization each have released guidance indicating that the COVID-19 coronavirus has not been detected in drinking water supplies, and emphasizing the continued safety of drinking water amidst the current COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic.

Specifically, the EPA has stated that the "coronavirus, which causes COVID-19, is a type of virus that is particularly susceptible to disinfection and standard treatment and disinfectant processes are expected to be effective."
