The Wayne County Water & Sewer Authority is seeking qualified candidates to interview for the position of **Water Distribution and Sewer Collection System Maintenance Worker/Construction.**

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES MAY INCLUDE (but are not limited to):

Assist work crews in the installation, repair, and general maintenance of water mains and sanitary collection systems. Repair and installation of fire hydrants, water mains, water services, and water valves. Assist in locating, raising, lowering, inspecting and repairing valves and pipes. Perform taps on street water mains for service to customers. Test for, locate, and repair leaks in cast-iron, ductile, and PVC water mains. Use all safety equipment assigned when necessary and operate equipment and perform all duties in a safe manner. Read and repair water meters. Complete sanitary manhole inspections, maintenance, and replacement. Assist in sanitary pump station monitoring, repair, and maintenance. Work with team members to install, repair, and replace sanitary sewer laterals and mains. May assist in the day-to-day operation of Waste Water Treatment Facilities overseen by the WCWSA. Perform clean up and surface restoration after completing WCWSA repairs and installation work. Keep assigned equipment, tools, supplies, and consumables in clean and good working order. Perform daily vehicle inspection and reports defects before and after operation in writing on required forms. May perform minor maintenance and upkeep to Wayne County Water & Sewer Authority buildings and grounds. Experience pertaining to Road Safety, Flagging Traffic, and Operating Heavy Equipment would be considered a plus.

Candidates must possess a valid New York State Class D license at time of application. NYS Commercial Driver's License is not required but would be preferred.
