WAYNE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY WALWORTH, NEW YORK WESTERN REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT - CONTRACT #2 REBID
GENERAL NOTICE: Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Western Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant - Contract #2 Rebid
In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the office of the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, located at 3377 Daansen Road, Walworth, New York 14568, until August 24, 2022, at 10:00 am local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

THE PROJECT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING WORK: The project consists of a comprehensive regional initiative to consolidate treatment of four (4) municipal wastewater treatment plants (WWTP) in Wayne County, New York. The four communities involved in the consolidation efforts are the Town of Marion, Town of Macedon, Village of Palmyra and Town of Walworth. The project consists of constructing pump stations at Marion, Macedon and Walworth treatment plants. The work generally includes: demolition of wastewater treatment plant structures, demolition of below grade pipes and utilities, mechanical demolition, decommissioning of WWTP's, site construction, fencing, drainage, site grading, asphalt paving, concrete/masonry tankage and building construction, equipment installation and process piping, electrical construction, plumbing construction, HVAC construction, Instrumentation and Controls for an overall Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system for the integration of the remote pump stations with the proposed WWTP system.

Force mains from each of the pump stations will be constructed conveying raw wastewater to the new Regional WWTP in Palmyra, NY. The work generally includes: Construction of force mains at varying sizes from 8-inch to 24-inch piping, forceman vault structures, air release vaults and other ancillary forceman components. Miscellaneous Site improvements including fencing, drainage, site grading and asphalt paving.

Contracts #1 and #3 were bid in recent months and only Contract #2 is being rebid. A new Regional WWTP will be constructed directly to the west of the existing Palmyra, NY Wastewater Treatment Plant (associated with Contract #1 and #3 recently bid in June 2022).

Bidding Documents will not be available from MRB Group or the Owner. A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on August 10, 2022 at 10:00 AM at 3377 Daansen Road, Walworth, New York 14568. The pre-bid conference will begin at 3377 Daansen Road and will be followed by site visits to each of the primary project locations for those who wish to attend. The Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority, Wayne County, New York, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities, or to make an award to other than the low bid-der. It further reserves the right to limit the amount of the award. Attention of the bidders is particularly directed to the requirements of the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum Wage Rates to be paid under the Contract. The Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.
